SURREY BASKETBALL PLAYING RULES 2011/2012

CVL teams please note: These rules are issued for information and are NOT the complete set of playing rules for Surrey Basketball Association, but have been extracted to give a view of those that also apply to Junior CVL teams. They may also be covered in more detail later in this Handbook under **Specific CVL playing rules which may supersede those below**. A complete set of rules can be provided on request or see the Senior Handbook.

The CVL Committee will use its discretion in the application of these rules as appropriate.

- **Playing Season**

The playing season shall be within the dates 1st October and 1 week after cup finals day. The cup final will be held at end of April/beginning May, but not Easter Sunday.

- **Number of Teams in a Division / Players in a Game**

The number of teams in a division will be at the discretion of the CVL Committee.

- **League Points**

Three points shall be awarded to the winning team and one point to the losing team. No points shall be awarded to a defaulting team.

- **Non-playing Regulations**

i. All Clubs are required to pay a one off Joining Fee of £50.00 to Surrey Basketball Association as a condition of entry into the Association's competitions for which additional entry fees will be charged. Any unpaid fines will be deducted from this at the end of the season.

The Joining Fee will then require "topping up" prior to the start of the following season.

Any club that withdraws from SBA competitions and who subsequently rejoin will be subject to a new joining fee.

ii. It is a condition of entry to the Surrey League that each Club must send a representative to the Annual General Meeting at the end of the season. A fine will be incurred for non-representation.

- **Playing Regulations**

Player Eligibility

- **Kit Regulations**

i. All teams shall wear uniform (vest and shorts). Teams are reminded to observe EB regulations regarding teeshirts (**i.e. none**) and undershorts (same colour but not showing below shorts). Players will be asked to remove any item that is not regulation kit.

In addition:

In any competition Final or semi-final event staged by SBA, players will **not** be allowed on court without correct team uniform.

- **Registration**

i. All clubs competing in the Surrey Basketball League must register its Club and players with the Surrey Registrar – John Cutts (contact details at the front of this handbook). Those teams not in the Surrey Area however competing in the Surrey Basketball League must obtain a Surrey League Licence from the Registrations Secretary who will issue a unique Surrey League Licence.

- ii. In all matches played after 31 October of the current season, all players must produce participants photographic Licence (photos must be stuck to the licence card or will not be accepted) to the scorer's table, at the same time the team lists are provided.
- iii. The **Players licence numbers must be included on the scoresheet**. It is the responsibility of both Coaches and Referees to ensure that this is done.
- iv. Coaches, referees and table officials should be licenced, either through their clubs, or direct to the Surrey Registrations Officer, John Cutts. Coaches and officials should also be CRB checked through England Basketball.

- **Clubs Having More Than One Team in The League**

- i. No player may play for more than one club in any Surrey Competition **including** the Cup Competition.
- ii. Clubs wishing to play more than one team in Cup competitions or the same League must declare and nominate all their players for each team prior to the first round of the cup and nominate 7 players from their better team who cannot play in their clubs 2nd team. No transfers can be made thereafter without the expressed permission of the Surrey CVL Committee.
- iii. No player may play for more than one team in the same division.

- **Transfers**

A player may transfer from one club to another only by written permission from the Surrey CVL Committee. Written intention to transfer must be received from the player and the two clubs concerned before permission can be granted.

- **Fixture Dates**

The schedules printed in the handbook shall be deemed to be confirmed. Fixtures can only be changed in exceptional circumstances and at the permission of the CVL Co-ordinators.

- **Postponed Games**

Hopefully the game will be re-arranged by mutual consent prior to the league closure dates.

The matter will be resolved by Surrey Committee whose decision will be final

- **Forfeiture of Points**

All games shall be played on the scheduled day, but any team failing to appear on court, ready to play, within 15 minutes of the scheduled Jump Ball time may be liable to forfeit all points at the discretion of the Surrey Committee. The team claiming the game must submit a scoresheet showing a 20-0 score, signed by two referees. If the match was played later than 15 minutes after the scheduled jump ball time, this scoresheet must also be submitted and, if sent to the League, the result will stand. In the event of the team failing to appear – the Officials must be paid their travelling expenses. In addition, a team failing to appear on court may, at the discretion of the Surrey Committee, be invoiced for some/all expenses incurred by the opposition.

- **Late Start**

Any game failing to make scheduled tip off time will be reported (by either team / official) to the CVL Committee who will make a decision on whether a fine be levied.

- **Player Disqualifications**

- i. If a player, coach or player/coach commits a disqualifying foul, he/she **MUST** leave the arena. There will be an automatic two (2) match ban from the team's next Surrey League games. If this ban is ignored, the team shall forfeit the match in which the ban should have been effective.
- ii. A full report by the referee must be sent to the CVL Co-ordinator within 5 working days. A player/coach who is disqualified can neither play nor coach during the two-match ban.

- iii. Teams will receive notification of the banned player, Coach or player/Coach
- iv. ALL disqualifications must be referred to the Disciplinary Committee where further action may be taken. All cases reviewed will be done on an individual basis and the Club will be notified of all action to be taken and decisions made by the Disciplinary Committee. The player, coach or player/coach's previous disciplinary record will be taken into consideration.
- v. The Disciplinary Committee will comprise 3 non-involved members from the Surrey Committee appointed through the Competitions Secretary.

• Appeals Procedure

- i. Clubs, teams or individual members have the right of appeal to the Surrey Basketball Committee on any fine imposed or on any decision that affects them, within 7 days of that fine or decision or on any dispute considered by the Surrey Basketball Committee to be within the League's jurisdiction.
- ii. Any appeal must be accompanied by the specified appeal fee of £50.00. On receipt of the appropriate fee the Appeals Committee will comprise the Surrey Chairman plus 2 non-involved members from the Surrey Committee. The Competitions Secretary, or member of the Senior Competitions Committee, will convene and hear the appeal.
- iii. Should the appeal be upheld, any monies paid may be returned as the Surrey Basketball Association deems appropriate. The club, team or individual making the appeal shall have the right to be represented when the appeal is heard. Reasonable notice having been given to the party or parties concerned.

• Fines

The CVL Co-ordinator will notify the Treasurer of any breach of rules incurring a fine. The Treasurer will then issue the appropriate fine to the Club(s) concerned. Fine details will be reported to the Surrey Executive Committee monthly meetings for ratification.

- Ineligible and unregistered players (ringer/BBL/plays for another team) **£50.00 plus loss of game**
- Failure to make scheduled tip-off time (as reported) **£5.00**
- Club non-attendance at Surrey AGM **£10.00**
- Teams responsible for unplayed fixtures:
 - 1. Will incur a **£10.00** administrative charge
 - 2. May well lose fixture 20-0 (at discretion of SBA Senior Cup Competition)
NB. 20-0 scoresheet required from claiming team
 - 3. May well be invoiced for expenses, court, referee, travel, via SBA from opponents

• Miscellaneous

Any other situations not covered by Surrey Basketball Rules above will be sanctioned by EB rules.

Please be advised that all players must be registered **PRIOR** to their first game and licence numbers must appear on scoresheets by **31 October**. Please allow sufficient time to get these in to John Cutts so they can be processed by the start of the season.

Surrey Central Venue League **GENERAL LEAGUE RULES** (Applicable to all age groups)

SBA provides table equipment for CVL games. Teams must provide their own training basketballs.

LEAGUE FORMAT

- The teams in each league play each other number of times dependant upon number of teams.
- The top 2 teams in each league then play each other in the cup final, unless there are play offs.
NB play-offs including the 3rd and 4th teams may be played if schedule time permits.
- The winning team scores 3 league points
- The losing team scores 1 league points
- Any team forfeiting a match scores 0 league points.
- At the end of the season if two or more teams are tied the final league positions will be determined as below.

MATCH FEES

- Match fees must be paid to the CVL Commissioner prior to the game.
- 2011/2012 Fees are: U10 - £40.00 per session,
U12 and U14 - £30 per game, U16 - £60 per game.

FINES:

- Any team failing to fulfil a fixture are liable to reimburse Surrey Basketball with the full cost of the game. I.e. equivalent to the match fees of both clubs, £60 U12&U14, £120 U16.
- The CVL committee will consider all cases of non-fulfilment of fixtures on their individual merit as it is understood that there may be extenuating circumstances.

REFEREES

- Without referees, teams would not be able to play any games. Coaches, players and supporters must treat them with respect at all times. The CVL pays the following:
- Referee payments (**inclusive of travel**) are:
Level 1 £7.50 – U12 and U14s. £15.00 – U16s
Level 2 and above U12 and U14s - £10.00 per game, U16: £20.00 per game
For U10s – All referees will receive £6.00 per game

TABLE OFFICIALS

- Each team must provide one Table Official capable of completing the scoresheet.
- **Failure to provide a Table Official will incur a penalty of one league point deducted for each infringement from and including the second session onwards.**
- Table Official payments (paid by CVL) are:
U12 and U14s - £5.00 per game. U16 - £7.50 per game
U10s - £4.00 per game

COMMISSIONERS

Surrey Basketball will provide Commissioners for the CVL for the current season.

The Commissioner will:

- Assist in setting up the court/s and table equipment
- Collect game fees from teams
- Oversee games and ensure officials are appointed and respected
- Pay officials at end of session and collect scoresheets
- Assist in putting away table equipment and tidying up.

It may be necessary to ask clubs to provide Commissioners in future.

TIED LEAGUE POSITIONS

In the event of a tie between teams come the end of the season, League standings will be determined by the following criteria in order:

1. A table shall be compiled taking into account only the matches played between teams involved in the tie. The teams shall then be placed in accordance with the points awarded for wins in this table.
2. In the event of further equality, the difference between the actual points scored and points conceded in these matches will be taken into account.
3. In the event of further equality, the difference between the actual points scored and points conceded in all matches in the League is taken into account.

Girls will be allowed to play in all CVL leagues. Girls who are one school year above the CVL age group will be able to play down, e.g. U12 girls (school year 7 from Sept) will not be allowed in the U10 league. We will let U11 Girls (Primary school) Year 6 play.

CODES OF CONDUCT

Basic standards of sportsmanship, such as players shaking hands, thanking referees and table officials are expected as a matter of common courtesy. Clubs are also responsible for the conduct of their officials and supporters who should likewise behave in a respectable manner towards all officials. Club contacts must make their Players, spectators, players' parents, and Coaches aware of the Codes of Conduct that are included in this Handbook.

Games to be played with **Size 6** Basketball

Timings: 4 x 7 minute quarters (stopping clock the whole game)

- 1 minute between each quarter, 3 minutes half time.
- A team may take 1 x 30 second time out per quarter
- Drawn Game – 1 minute play starting with a jump ball and if still a draw, then sudden death

Players:

- You can field a maximum of 12 players, minimum of 10.
- A team must play five of their players in the first quarter and the other five in the second quarter.
- Any team having less than ten players at a game will give **five points per player short** to their opponent's score which will be added on at the **half time** of the game.
- **NB: If a team has more than 12 players registered for the age group then the points will be added if less than 10 players turn up on the day.**
If a team has less than 12 players registered at the beginning of season but recruits further during the season, then they will be expected to field at least 10 players at CVL games.
- No substitutions are permitted in the first half, i.e. 1st and 2nd quarters.

Fouls:

- 4 personal fouls only.
- 4 team fouls per quarter.

Games to be played with **Size 6** Basketball

Timings: 4 x 7 minute quarters (stopping clock the whole game)

- 1 minute between each quarter, 3 minutes half time.
- A team may take 1 x 30 second time out per quarter
- Drawn Game – 1 minute play starting with a jump ball and if still a draw, then sudden death

Players:

- You can field a maximum of 12 players, minimum of 10.
- A team must play five of their players in the first quarter and the other five in the second quarter.
- Any team having less than ten players will give **five points per player short** to their opponent's score which will be added on at the **half time** of the game.
- **NB: If a team has more than 12 players registered for the age group then the points will be added if less than 10 players turn up on the day.**
If a team has less than 12 players registered at the beginning of season but recruits further during the season, then they will be expected to field at least 10 players at CVL games.
- No substitutions are permitted in the first half, i.e. 1st and 2nd quarters.

Fouls:

ACS INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL (COBHAM)

By road

At Junction 10 on the M25 exit onto the A3 signed London (SW), and Kingston. Keep left and turn off at the first exit signed Painshill, A245 Cobham. At the roundabout keep right and follow signs to Leatherhead and Cobham on the A245. Continue over the first mini roundabout, and at the second roundabout turn left to Esher on the A307. Continue for 1 mile (passing the Fairmile Premier Lodge on the left), the entrance to ACS Cobham International School is another 250 yards further on the left. The School is approximately 4 miles from Junction 10 on the M25.

Please note there is no direct access to the School from the A3. If travelling from London on the A3, take the A307 turning to Esher just after the Tolworth underpass. Continue over the first roundabout, and at the second roundabout turn left for Esher. Drive through Esher town center. After approximately 2 miles (passing Upper Court on the left), ACS is another 500 yards on the right immediately after the A3 flyover.

By train

Take South West trains from Waterloo to either Esher Station or Cobham & Stoke D'Abernon Station. The journey takes about 30 minutes, and trains depart twice an hour. Taxis are available from both stations.

Coaches Code of Conduct

- Set a good example, which others can follow.
- Arrive in plenty of time to set up your activities and ensure safety.
- Children play for pleasure and winning is only part of the fun.
- Keep yourself informed about sound coaching practices and the principles of children's growth and development.
- Be reasonable in your demands on children's time, energy and enthusiasm - they need other interests too.
- The successful coach invests in the wellbeing and interests of their players, not their win/loss record.
- Teach your team that honest effort is more important than victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Never ridicule or shout at a child for making a mistake or losing.
- Teach players to be fair and to follow the rules.
- Divide your time equally between all standards of players.
- Check you have adequate insurance cover for the coaching you are undertaking!
- Ensure you and your players have respect for their opponents, the officials and opposing coaches and supporters.
- Follow advice from a professional when determining if an injured player is ready to play or train.
- Take responsibility for the young people in your care until they have safely left the activity.

Spectators Code of Conduct

- Remember that children play organised sports for their own enjoyment. They are not there to entertain you.
- Be on your best behaviour. Do not use profane language or harass, physically or verbally, players, managers, coaches, referees or assistant referees.
- Applaud all good play by your own team and other teams.
- Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them, there would be no game.
- Never ridicule or scold a child for making a mistake during a game.
- Condemn the use of violence and verbal abuse.
- Respect the match officials' decisions. Remember he/she is only human with the same feelings as you and, like you, sometimes makes an honest error.
- Encourage players always to play according to the Laws of the Game.
- Read the Laws of the Game to better understand what you are looking at and commenting on.

Players Code of Conduct

- Arrive for training and matches in good time to prepare thoroughly.
- Turn up with appropriate kit for the activity.
- Always warm up and cool down properly.
- Play for fun and enjoyment - not just to please your parents and/or coach.
- Learn and play by the rules.
- Do not argue with match officials and/or the coach - use your energies for playing better.
- Recognise and applaud all good play.
- Be a good sport - win with modesty, lose with dignity.
- Respect other people - treat them, as you would wish to be treated.
- Co-operate with coach, teammates and opponents.
- Think about improving your skills after training and competition.
- Inform the coach of any injury as soon as possible.
- Inform the coach if you need to leave the event early.

Parents Code of Conduct

- Remember that children play for their fun, not yours!
- Encourage children to play, do not force them.
- Praise your child's efforts whether they win or lose.
- Applaud all good play.
- Never ridicule a child for losing or making a mistake.
- Children learn best by following a good example.
- Learn the rules to better understand what you are looking at and commenting on.
- Show your appreciation to all officials, coaches and helpers.
- Condemn the use of violence, profane language and any form of abuse.
- Think of how you can best help the coach and/or the club.

SBA CONSTITUTION

1. TITLE

The Association shall be known as the Surrey Basketball Association hereinafter referred to as the Association.

2. MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the Association shall be open to all clubs in the Surrey area subject to the approval of the Association Committee, and to any other clubs invited by the Association.

3. ENTRY INTO THE ASSOCIATION

3.1 Each team entering the Association shall pay an annual entrance fee to play in the relevant league or cup competition.

There will also be a joining fee for new clubs as set by SBA Executive Committee.

Clubs who leave the SBA will be subject to pay current joining fee if they seek re-admission.

Any club owing money to SBA from fines, etc., must settle their account before the AGM of that season. Failure to comply will mean a deduction from their joining fee and a top up required to current fee to continue participation in the league.

3.2 The requisite monies shall accompany all applications for entry into the Association.

3.3 Each player shall normally be registered with the Association and the EBBA for the club for which he/she plays; should he/she be nationally registered for another club, he/she must be registered with the Association before first game of the playing season. All registration requirements must be completed before the player participates in an Association fixture.

3.4 The playing rules of the Association are the terms of registration to the Association and the signature of the Club Secretary on the application form constitutes acceptance of these rules and the decisions of the Association Officials and Committees.

4. OFFICERS

4.1 The Officers of the Association shall consist of a Chairman, Association Secretary, Treasurer, Development Officers, Technical Officers.

4.2 Officers shall be elected from Clubs constituting the Association and from officials included in the Surrey Association handbook or any other person as so forwarded and seconded by any official of the Association.

4.3 The Association shall be governed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the EBBA.

5. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

5.1 The AGM of the Association shall be held no later than six weeks after the end of the playing season.

5.2 The Officers of the Association shall be elected at this meeting.

5.3 At least 28 days' clear notice of this meeting shall be given, in writing, to all clubs.

5.4 The Association Secretary, in writing, must receive notice of proposed amendments to this constitution at least 14 days before the AGM and the Association Secretary should circulate these to all clubs within 7 days.

5.5 Each team participating in the Association for the season preceding the AGM shall be entitled to one vote. Elected officers for that preceding season shall be entitled to one vote in their capacity as such. No person shall have more than two votes. No person can represent more than one team.

5.6 Over 50% of eligible voting members shall constitute a quorum, of which a majority shall have to vote in favour if changes to this constitution are to be made.

5.7 Any team, being a Association member, which fails to send a representative to any General Meeting of the Association, will be fined a maximum of £10.00

6. GENERAL MEETING

6.1 A Special General Meeting (or Pre Season Meeting) may be convened at any time at the discretion of the Association Committee.

6.2 The Association Secretary must convene a Meeting on receiving a requisition signed by five clubs in the Association

6.3 Section 5.5 to 5.7 shall apply to all General Meetings.

7. ASSOCIATION COMMITTEE

7.1 The Officers of the Association shall constitute the Association Committee

7.2 Any other person may be co-opted at the discretion of the Association Committee with or without voting power.

7.3 Subject to subsection 7.2, each committee member shall be entitled to one vote at committee meetings but no member may vote in any matter pertaining to his/her own club. In the event of the voting being equal the Chairman shall have the casting vote.

7.4 Three voting members shall constitute a quorum.

7.5 The Association Committee shall set up an Executive Sub-Committee to deal with disciplinary issues. The Sub-Committee shall constitute at least three Committee members but non-voting members can be co-opted as appropriate.

8. FUNCTION OF THE ASSOCIATION COMMITTEE

8.1 The Association Committee shall govern the Association in all matters appertaining to it in accordance with the Association playing rules or in any manner it deems fit when specific provision is not made in these rules.

8.2 In exceptional circumstances the Association Committee may, if it considers appropriate, waive certain of the Association playing rules.

8.3 Clubs and individuals shall have the right to appeal in person to the Association Committee.

9. FINANCE

The Association Financial year shall run from 1st September to the 31st August.

The Association Accounts shall be produced at the Pre Season Meeting to be held in September. At the AGM the Treasurer shall give a summary of the accounts as at that date and an estimated projection to 31 August.

If the Association folds or no longer is functional then all monies in the accounts of the Association shall revert to the EBBA (English Basketball Association).

10. POWER OF INTERPRETATION

10.1 The Power of Interpretation of this constitution shall be vested in the Association Committee except during a General Meeting when the Chairman may interpret alone.
